#### **PUBLIC SESSION**

After further comments by Board members, Board Chair Grayson asked for a vote on Director Keker's motion. Upon this motion being duly made and seconded, the Board unanimously voted not to proceed with the respondent's Campus for Change proposal and to close the Fort Scott RFP process.
