Getting Around

PRESIDIO GO SHUTTLE

Take the free Presidio Go Shuttle to and around the park. It has two routes:

GO DOWNTOWN Route
(30-minutes one-way)
Service to and from Salesforce Transit Center, Embarcadero BART, and Van Ness Avenue/Union Street.

GO SOUTH HILLS Route
(30-minute loop)
Stops include Inspiration Point, Baker Beach, Rob Hill Campground, and the Inn at the Presidio.

BIKE RENTALS

Use a smartphone to find and unlock shared electric and classic bikes with the Lyft app (see bike share station locations on map). Bikes and surreys are available for rent at Sports Basement at Crissy Field. PRESIDIO.GOV/BIKING



PRESIDIO VISITOR CENTER

Plan a great day in the park with the help of a ranger. Enjoy videos, exhibits, and a changing collection of park clothing, books, and mementos.



GOLDEN GATE BRIDGE

This icon is San Francisco's most famous destination. Start your adventure at the Golden Gate Bridge Welcome Center to see artifacts from when the bridge was built in the 1930s before walking or biking across the 1.7-mile span.



PRESIDIO TUNNEL TOPS

This new destination, built on the Presidio Parkway tunnels, offers views, picnic tables, trails, and a campfire circle. At the Outpost, kids swing, crawl, and climb on huge play structures inspired by nature. The Field Station invites kids to explore with their senses.



BATTERY BLUFF

Located along the Presidio Promenade, Battery Bluff blends history and nature. Its name nods to the recently repaired historic gun batteries nestled in the hillside above Crissy Field. Enjoy a picnic while taking in views of the Golden Gate Bridge.



PRESIDIO OFFICERS' CLUB

Presidio Officers' Club, first established in 1776, is the park's most historic building. Its museum with exhibits tracing the Presidio's past and present is free and open to the public Saturdays from 11 am to 4 pm.



CRISSY MARSH

Located on the Golden Gate Promenade/Bay Trail at Crissy Field, the marsh is surrounded by wildflowers. More than 100 birds visit the marsh as they travel along the Pacific Flyway. At nearby East Beach, play in the waves, make a sandcastle, or picnic.



FORT POINT NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE

Located beneath the Golden Gate Bridge, the fort defended San Francisco Bay from after the Gold Rush through World War II. A visit here makes history come to life. See hours of operation at nps.gov/fopo.



BAKER BEACH

This one-mile stretch of sandy beach is the perfect spot to catch some rays, put your toes in the sand, or enjoy a beautiful sunset. Barbeque pits and picnic tables are available. The Batteries to Bluffs Trail connects to nearby Marshall's Beach.



INSPIRATION POINT + WATERSHED WALK

Take in views of the bay, Alcatraz, and Angel Island from this overlook above the park's largest watershed. Walk north along the Ecology Trail to the Tennessee Hollow Trail to experience El Polín Spring and Quartermaster Reach Marsh.



WOOD LINE

Artist Andy Goldsworthy fills a gap in the Presidio's largest eucalyptus grove with a 1,200-foot-long sculpture made from eucalyptus branches. *Wood Line* is near Lovers' Lane trail and is one of his four sculptures in the park.
