

Small Weddings & Ceremonies. Your reservation is only for the designated location (“Reservation Location”) identified in your Reservation and only during the times specified in your Reservation. The name of the individual (“Reservation Holder”) responsible for your group must be present at the location with a hard or digital copy of the confirmation email from Recreation.gov for the entire duration of the reservation. The Reservation Holder cannot assign the Reservation to any other individual or group. The Reservation Holder must vacate the location no later than the end time stated on the Reservation (e.g., if your Reservation time is between 9 AM -1:00 PM, you must vacate the Reservation Location by 1:00 PM). No refunds will be given for late or no-shows.

Small Wedding & Ceremony Use. You may use your designated Reservation Location solely for small ceremonies and for no other purpose whatsoever. The number of persons at your location cannot exceed the reservation group size (25). You are only allowed to hire an acoustic musician (1) and photographer (1). You are prohibited from hiring additional third-party vendors (e.g., catering, beverage service, food trucks) to provide services at your Reservation Location. You may bring up to 6 folding chairs to your Reservation Location and no other furniture is permitted.

The Trust reserves the right at any time and from time to time to change, add to, subtract from, or alter any part of the Reservation Location(s) or any other reservation rights to use parts of the Presidio. The Trust will not be subject to liability, nor will Reservation Holder be entitled to compensation because of such changes. The Trust will not be liable to Reservation Holder for interference or inconvenience caused by any such action of the Trust.

Express Prohibitions. You are prohibited from: the use of weapons or controlled substances (other than prescription drugs); sparklers, generators, third party vendors other than approved musician and photographer; tents including popup tents. Alcoholic beverages are allowed in accordance with [36 CFR § 1002.35](#). Disorderly conduct is prohibited.

No Alternations and No Attachment of Decorations. Decorations on trees or other surrounding surfaces or vegetation is prohibited. Balloons, confetti, flower pedals, rice, streamers, glitter, piñatas, water balloons, and other similar items that will litter the site are prohibited.

Acoustic or Amplified Sound. DJs are not permitted. Live or recorded sound may not exceed a 60 db at an A rated scale at a distance of 50 feet and must not disturb other visitors, residents, and tenants. Reservation Holder may be required to adjust sound levels or terminate amplification at any time by direction of the onsite Trust staff. Small portable tabletop speakers are permitted.

Cancellation for Violation. If the Reservation Holder and any member of their group violate the Terms and Conditions of the reservation, the Trust, in addition to and other remedies available to it under this reservation, at law, in equity or otherwise, may immediately cancel this reservation by written or verbal notice; and the Reservation Holder shall promptly surrender the Reservation Location in accordance with the Terms and Conditions of this reservation. The Reservation Holder acknowledges and agrees that if the Trust cancels this reservation, the Trust shall be entitled to retain any remaining portion of the security deposit that has not otherwise been used to satisfy any of the Reservation Holder’s obligations herein. Further, in the event that the Trust cancels this reservation, the Reservation Holder acknowledges and agrees that the Trust may retain all other fees and charges paid by the Reservation Holder to the Trust pursuant to the Terms and Conditions of this reservation. This reservation may be revoked upon 24 hours’ notice, or without notice, if damage to the Reservation Location, other resources or facilities is threatened, notwithstanding any other stated terms or conditions of this reservation to the contrary. All costs associated with clean up or damage repairs in conjunction with a revoked reservation are the responsibility of the Reservation Holder.

Compliance with Applicable Law. The Reservation Holder shall comply, and shall cause all Reservation Holder’s guests, visitors, and invitees (collectively, “Reservation Holder’s Parties”) to comply with all regulations of the

Trust and all applicable statutes, regulations, requirements, licenses, rules, guidelines, ordinances, codes, orders, decrees, and the like (collectively, “Applicable Law”). The laws of the United States shall govern the validity, construction, and effectiveness of this reservation, without diminishing any of Reservation Holder’s foregoing obligations with respect to other aspects of Applicable Law. Non-Exclusive Use. Your Small Wedding and Ceremony location is a shared space. Your Reservation entitles you only to the use of your reservation location. In making this reservation, you acknowledge and accept that your use of the Reservation Location might be subject to interruptions outside of the Trust’s control, including but not limited to recreational activities of other park visitors.

Clean Up: Reservation Holder is responsible for maintaining the Reservation Location in good condition and for removal of all items brought to Reservation Location by Reservation Holder or guests. All [trash, recycling, and compost should be sorted](#) and placed in the appropriate receptacles that are provided on-site.

Surrender: The Reservation Holder is responsible for maintaining the Reservation Location in good condition. Upon revocation or other termination of this Reservation, the Reservation Holder shall surrender the Reservation Location in the same condition as received, free from hazards and clear of all debris, and in good, neat and clean condition. Personal property left on Trust administered property is not the responsibility of the Trust and may be disposed of by the Trust with no obligation to the Reservation Holder or Reservation Holder’s Parties.

Assumption of Risk; Indemnity; Waiver, Release. The Reservation Holder agrees (on behalf of themselves and those in their group) to assume the risk of any harm or damage that may befall the Reservation Holder or any member of their group while at the Reservation Location. The Reservation Holder further understands and agree that the Presidio Trust (and its directors, officers, employees, contractors, and agents) (collectively, the “Presidio Parties”) are not responsible for loss, destruction, or damage to property; nor are the Presidio Parties responsible for the death or injury of any persons at the East Meadow. This assumption of risk shall not apply to exempt anyone from responsibility for his own fraud, or willful injury to the person or property of another, or violation of law, whether willful or negligent. This assumption of risk shall survive termination and/or expiration of this Reservation.

Force Majeure. The Trust shall not be liable for any failure to perform any act related to this reservation when such failure is caused by a Force Majeure occurrence. “Force Majeure” means any fire or other casualty, strikes, lockouts or other labor disturbances, power shortages or outages, pandemic, epidemic, outbreak of infectious disease, quarantine or other public health crises, embargo, acts or omissions by third parties, extraordinary unavailability of materials or supplies, act of terrorism, riot or war.

Security Deposit. A \$50.00 deposit is required at the time of booking. Deposits will be refunded if all Terms and Conditions are followed including leaving the Reservation Location clean at the end of this reservation. Without limiting such other rights and remedies as may be available to the Trust, Reservation Holder acknowledges and agrees that the Trust shall be entitled to hold, use, and apply the Security Deposit for the full and timely performance of Reservation Holder’s obligations under this reservation, including without limitation, to reimburse the Trust for additional cleaning costs and additional fees that may arise when the Reservation Location is surrendered by Reservation Holder. The use or application of the Security Deposit by the Trust shall not be construed as liquidated damages. Subject to the Terms and Conditions of this reservation, the Trust agrees that any unused portion of the Security Deposit shall be refunded to the Reservation Holder by complying with the Trust requirements, within sixty (60) days after the Reservation Holder has surrendered the Reservation Location, or cancelled this reservation, in accordance with cancellation policy.

Cancellation. Cancellations made more than 14 days before the scheduled arrival date, will be refunded the use fee and the deposit less a \$10.00 cancellation fee. No refunds will be given for cancellations made 14 days or less before

the scheduled arrival date. The Trust will make exceptions to the standard 14-day refund window when there is rain in the forecast on your scheduled reservation date or when the AQI is forecasted to be in the Orange range (Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups) or above on your reservation date. To request a cancellation and refund for rain or air quality, you must email your request to picnic@presidiotrust.gov or call (415) 561-5083 no later than 10 am on your scheduled reservation date. The \$10.00 cancellation fee will apply.
